This is a handsome state-of the art 330,000 square foot, five story showplace in a brand new building on 11th Avenue at 54th Street.

After lunch, Mike Ziegler drove us to the Park Avenue MB showroom. This showroom is very impressive. Autocross at Sun Motors

On September 25, we returned to Sun Motors for another great autocross. Sales manager, Mike Lombardi, set up our second event at their dealership this year. Sun provided the lot and the cones, which made this event possible. Please say thanks to their staff the next time you stop by.

We had an interesting mix of MB's, from new to classic. Mike Hund's 1967 230SL was by far the oldest, Max Copenheaver's smart, aka Dr. Evil, was the smallest, and Brad Eisenhauer's S600 Renntech was definitely the most powerful. The course featured a slalom, tight and sweeping turns, and a circle. Max's Dr. Evil tried to make up for its lack of power by cutting all the turns as tight as possible. Brad's Black Beast couldn't wait to let loose on the short straights to put its 700+ horsepower to use. From the twin turbos, to the exhaust notes, it produced delightful sounds on every run. As an instructor, I got the thrill of experiencing controlled slides in a 230SL and SLK280 in the same turn. No matter what model you drive, you can always learn something new about your Mercedes.

Thanks to our special guest Bill Hopper, from the Greater Washington Section, currently the Eastern Regional Director. He brought a box of loaner helmets and helped me instruct the drivers all morning. Thanks to everyone who volunteered to set-up and work the course and timing desk. This autocross ran even smoother than our past ones.

While we promote our autocrosses as driver education, we do divide the participants into classes. The drivers try to improve their own times throughout the day. Once again, the official runs after lunch showed great improvement from the practice times. We hope to have at least one autocross at Sun next year. If you haven't tried it, you don't know what you're missing.

Road Rally through Perry County in October

Our 2011 fall rally was held on the bright, sunny Sunday afternoon of October 16. There were 8 cars entered. Drivers and navigators were given the instructions for the rally course and the first car rolled out of the start position right on time. Cars were started every 6 minutes with the expectation that the rally course would take approximately two and a half hours. Each car was, also, provided a rescue packet that would only be used if the driver/navigator team deemed it necessary. This packet contained the name and address of the end point of the rally.

The object of the rally was two-fold. First the mileage of the car should have been the same mileage as the Rally Masters (Karen Kaiser and Robert Byrne) obtained when they ran the course. Second the instructions for the course also contained questions that had to be answered about things that were visible from the course. For each correct answer to the questions two points were awarded. For every tenth of a mile difference from the Rally Masters mileage a single point was subtracted from the point total. A tie-breaker question that was not in the written instructions was asked at the end of the Rally.

Seven cars arrived at the end point of the rally. An alternator problem on one car caused it to be left on the course – the driver and navigator were given a ride for the rest of the course by Brad & Gloria Oldenburg. One of the seven cars made use of their rescue packet. Six cars were in the running for trophies. The winners of the trophies were:

First Place: Joe and Richel Papapietro (new members to the section)

Second Place: Marty & Jan Rexroth assisted by their two kids

Third Place: Frank & Vicki Alfone (also new members to the section)

The end point of the Rally was Rillo's Restaurant in Carlisle, PA. Dinner and stories of the rally were told and a good time was had by all.
